HISTORY

Buckingham Palace is located in the heart of London, surrounded by the lavish parks of St. James and Green Park. Built in 1703 and originally called Buckingham House, the palace was designed by English architect William Winde as a private residence for the Duke of Buckingham.



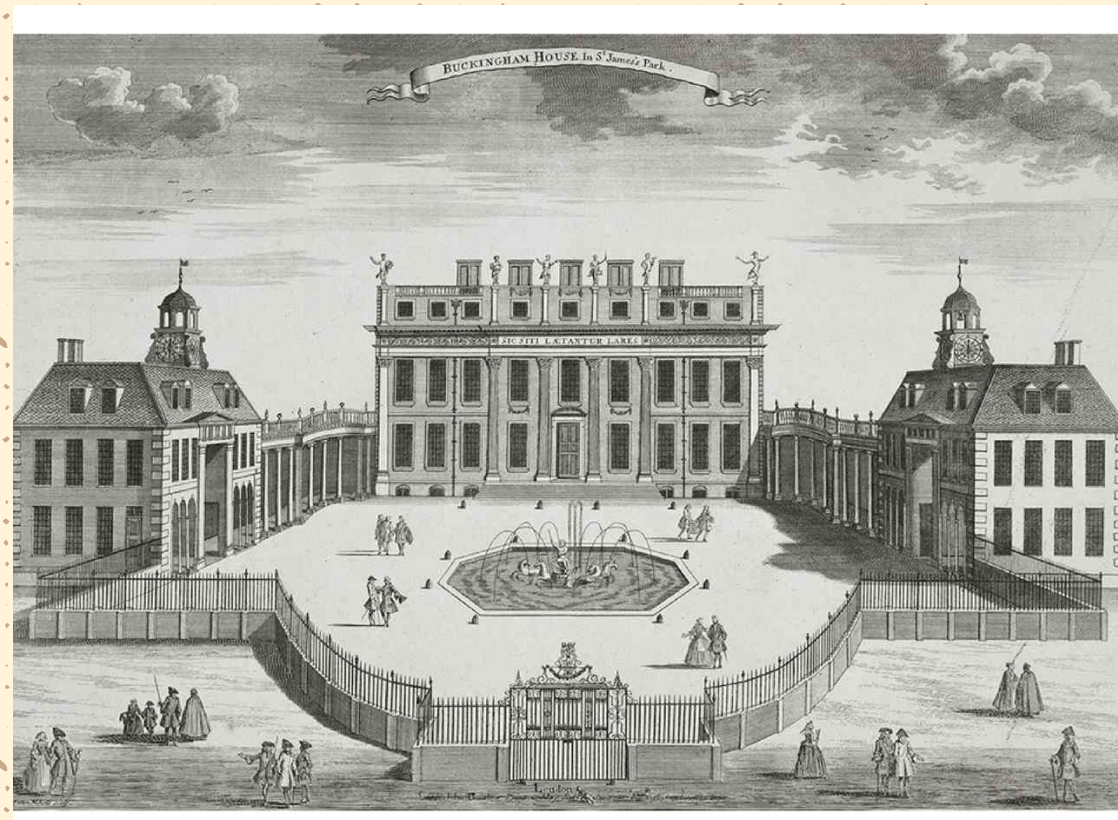
THE ROYAL COLLECTION

In 1837 this historic building became the official residence of the British sovereigns in London.



The dimensions of this historic structure are overwhelming: 108 meters of façade, 120 meters deep and 24 meters high. Inside, it has 19 state rooms, 52 royal and guest rooms, 188 staff rooms, 92 offices and 78 bathrooms. But Buckingham Palace is much more than a home.
