BOOK 3 LESSONS 1, 2 AND 3

Tuesday, March 5th, 2024.

GRAMMAR: Students should know how to use **Punctuation Marks and Commas.**

Period: Used to mark the end of a statement. (.)

Exclamation point: Helps to express a command or a strong feeling. (!)

Question mark: Is used at the end of interrogative sentences. (?)

Comma: Used to separate words in simple series of three or more items and before conjunctions. (,)

Students should know how to use **Acronyms.**

Examples: FYI (For Your Information), ASAP (As Soon As Possible), IMO (In My Opinion), TTYL (Talk To You Later), BTW (By The Way), N/A (Not Available), OMG (Oh My God!), LOL (Laughing Out Loud) OMW (On My Way), IDK (I Don't Know), JK (Just Kidding), BFF (Best Friend Forever), BRB (Be Right Back)

Students should know how to use **Object Pronouns.**

Remember that the Object Pronoun is the one that RECEIVES the action.

Subject Pronoun	Object Pronoun
I	Me
You	You
He	Him
She	Her

Subject Pronoun	Object Pronoun
It	It
We	Us
You	You
They	Them

Examples

- I bought Tom a new cellphone. I bought him a new cellphone.
- The doctor told my family and I to be healthy. The doctor told us to be healthy.

Students should know how to use **Verb To Have**.

We use verb HAVE to express possession, an action or an experience:

- I have one apartment in Miami.
- I had a wonderful time at Disneyland.
- I had a nap after school.

VERBS: Students should practice, study and learn regular and irregular verbs in infinitive form, base form, simple past and past participle. Students should understand that a verb is **a word used to describe an action, state or occurrence**.

Students should conjugate the following verbs as we do it in our booklet, using the affirmative, interrogative and negative form in simple present, present continuous, simple past and future with will.
